

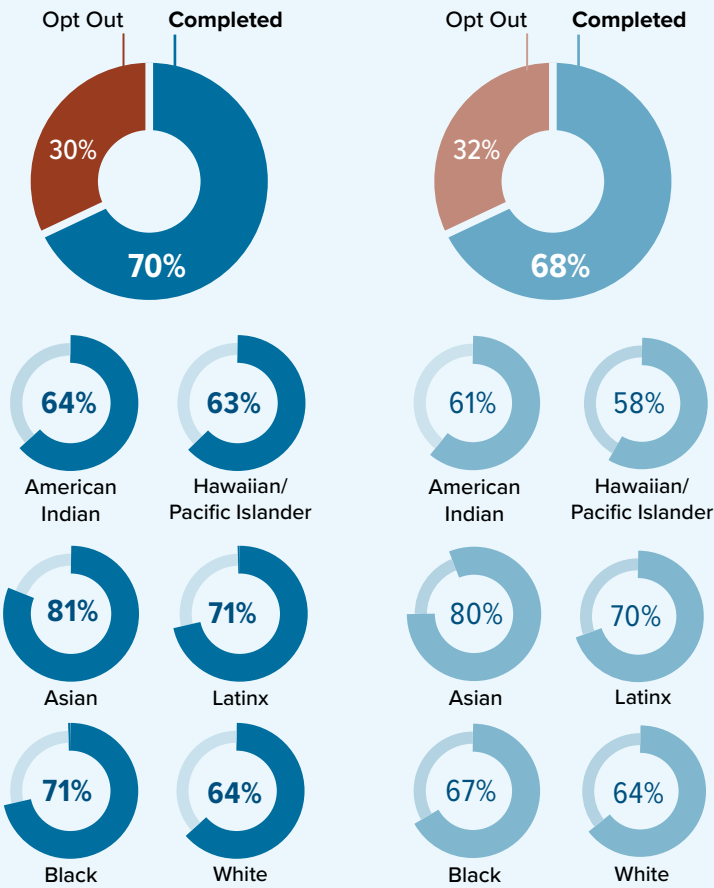
Financial Aid Application Completion for Texas Public High School Graduates

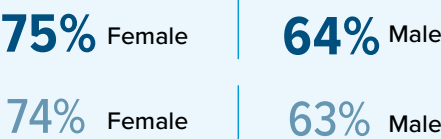

BY RACE/ETHNICITY



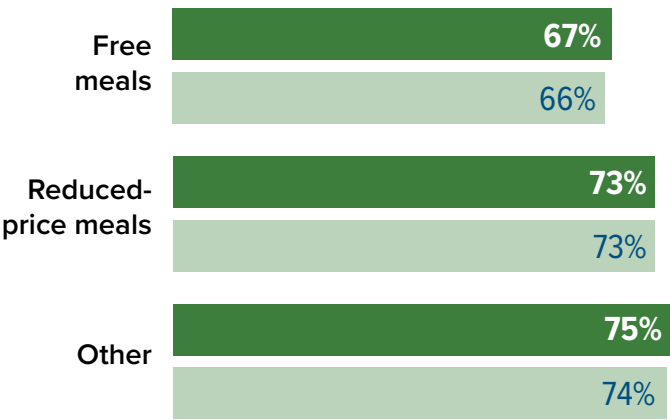
BY GENDER



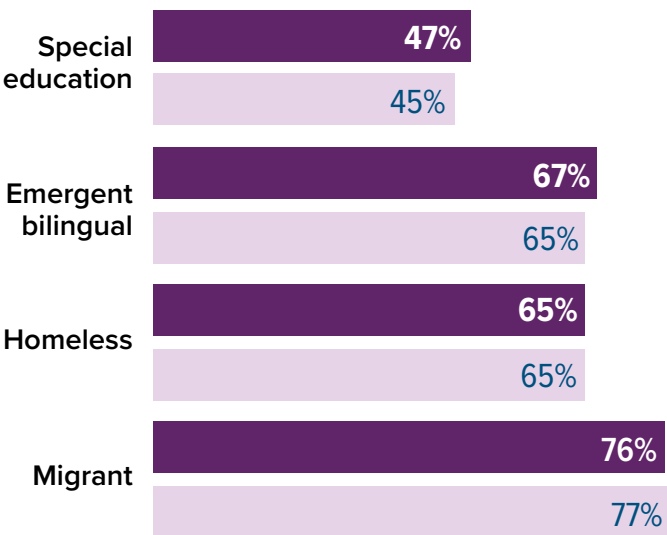
2022 – lighter colors 2023 – darker colors



BY ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTAGED TYPE

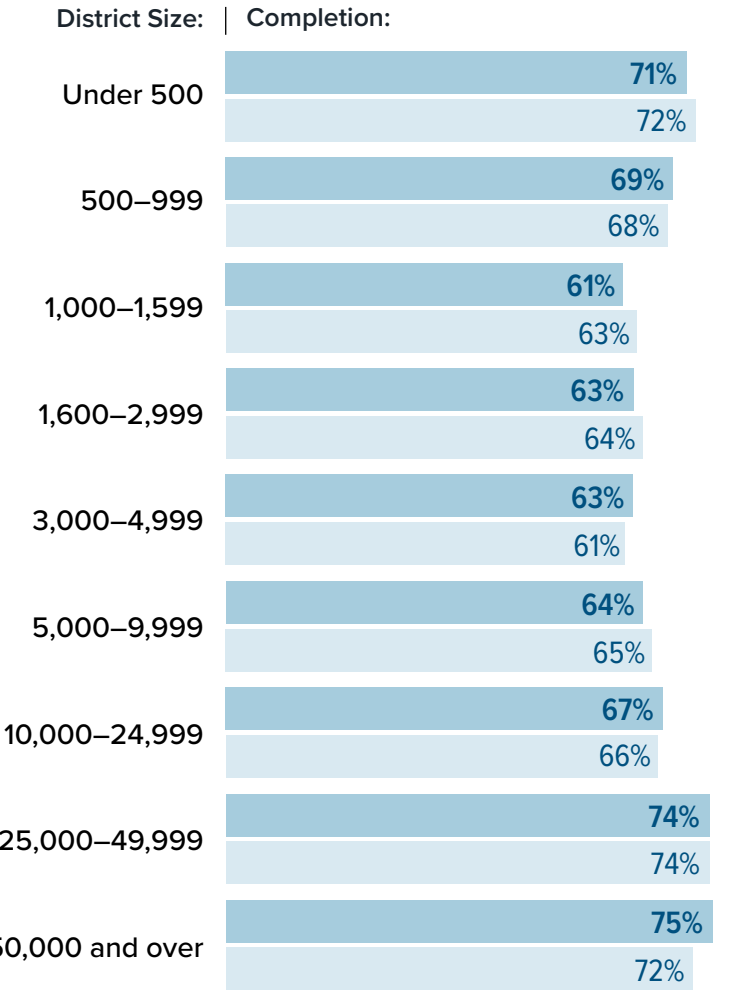


BY SPECIAL POPULATIONS



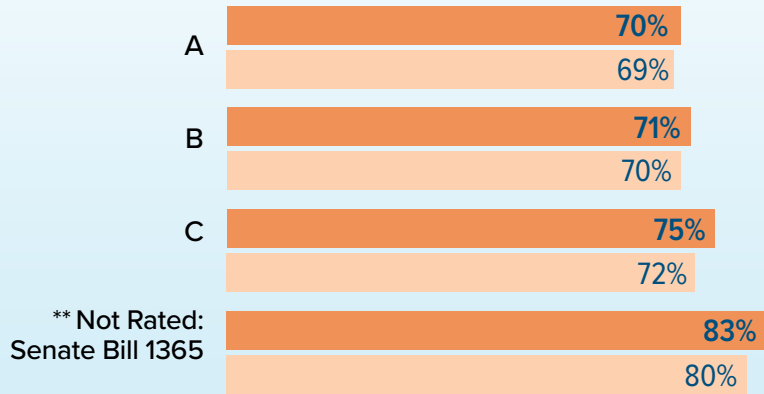
BY DISTRICT CHARACTERISTICS*

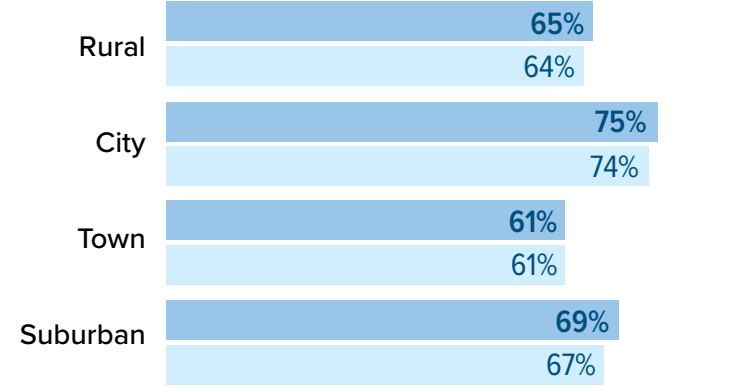

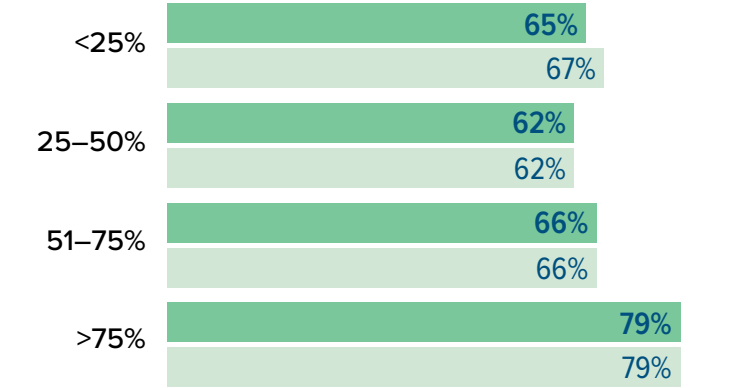

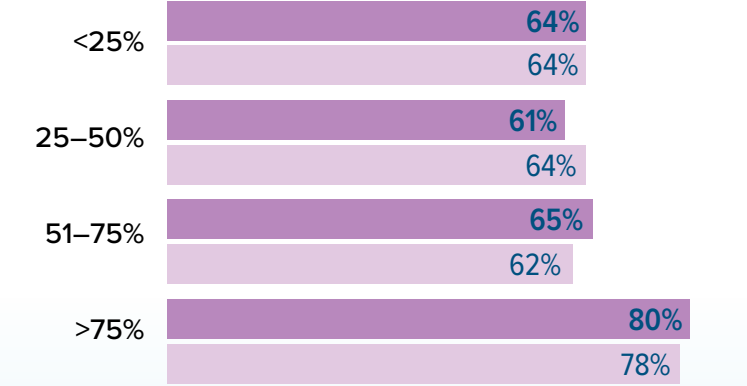
District Locale
