Are the outcomes within the scope of the program's (or intervention's) control or reasonable sphere of influence? If not, should the model be modified?		
Are the outcomes related to program goals/priorities?		
If the model specifies a time line, is it reasonable?		
If impacts are stated, do they follow logically from the outcomes?
